### About This Role

This internship is funded through Full Potential Lambeth and is designed to give a young person (aged 17-25) real, practical industry experience while being paid the London living Wage.

The Intern Wig Technician supports the delivery of REVAMP's wig revamp, repair, and restoration services. This is a hands-on, hybrid role focused on learning foundational wig care techniques while supporting senior revampers with day-to-day service delivery.

The role is designed as a learning and development position. All technical work is carried out under supervision, with progression based on skill development, consistency, and quality standards.

### Skills & Qualities We're Looking For

- Strong attention to detail and care when handling client items
- Willingness to learn and take direction
- Reliable, organised, and methodical approach to tasks
- Comfortable working in a studio environment

### Key Responsibilities

#### **Wig Preparation & Handling**

- Receive, log, and safely handle client wigs in line with REVAMP care protocols
- Prepare wigs for service, including detangling, sectioning, and mounting on blocks or mannequins
- Clean and sanitise wigs, tools, and workstations in accordance with hygiene standards

#### **Support with Wig Services**

- Assist senior revampers with washing, deep conditioning, blow-drying, and basic styling

- Assist with wig reconstruction preparation, including cap preparation, measuring, pinning, and stitching support
- Learn to identify common wig issues such as thinning, shedding, lace damage, and cap distortion

### **Quality Control & Documentation**

- Photograph wigs before, during, and after services in line with internal documentation standards
- Check completed wigs against service briefs and flag any concerns to senior revampers
- Update job notes accurately and ensure wigs are correctly labelled throughout the process

### **Studio Operations**

- Maintain a clean, organised, and safe studio environment
- Prepare packaging for outgoing wigs, including nets, bags, care cards, and labels

### **Client Care (Non-Contact)**

- Handle client wigs with discretion, care, and sensitivity at all times
- Support internal teams by preparing visual updates when required
- Maintain awareness of the needs of clients experiencing medical hair loss
